

## Hole-by-hole

**5<sup>th</sup>**

### **Rear greenside bunker on left**

This bunker is causing problems and is becoming unplayable with clay coming up from below. It is being considered whether to turf it over, but leaving the contours in place. It may also be effective to allow the grass to grow in this area.



**6<sup>th</sup>**

The only part of the course situated on clay.

The bunkers on this hole appear to suffer the worst from stones.

### **1<sup>st</sup> bunker on left at top of the hill**

This has bad drainage, due to the clay. The water regularly collects in it. This compacts the sand and leaves it hard when dried out. It will require re-basing and so will be made GUR whilst this is carried out. **NOTE** Do not assume they are GUR unless you see a sign to that effect. It will also be re-edged.



### **2<sup>nd</sup> bunker on left**

As for bunker above

### **1<sup>st</sup> bunker on right, in dip**

As per both bunkers above



**8<sup>th</sup>**

### **Tee area**

It is envisioned that a bench dedicated to the memory of Elfed Davies be placed here.

**9<sup>th</sup>**

### **New tee**

This is now ready for use by members. It has yet to be measured and no tee furniture has been put in place yet. It is hoped that it will first be used on the Captains Charity Day. The Pro Shop will inform members when they can use the tee.

### **Left greenside bunker and fairway in front of green**

Both these areas suffer from awful drainage. We believe it to be a blocked/broken drain.

The drain needs to be dug up, in order to see what the problem is.



## 10<sup>th</sup>

### **Pathway between yellow and red tees**

This area suffers from bad drainage, which we are aware of

### **Fairway around the dogleg, opposite huge bunker on right**

Again this area suffers from bad drainage. This is due to the drains running into the river, alongside the fairway. Once the river level reaches the drains, the problems occur.



## 11<sup>th</sup>

### **Overhanging poplar tree on left ahead of the red tees**

This will be trimmed back, as it appears to be impeding tee shots from the red markers.

### **Pond by green**

As described in impending work, a bridge is being built across the pond to link the buggy path and the green. It will go across the area of the old bunker.

During the winter, the pond banks will be slightly re-shaped and cut to blend into the grass. This should improve the drainage from in front of the green as the drains running from there can now drain out into the old bunker.

## 16<sup>th</sup>

### **Old bunker area on right at dogleg**

This area, between the end of the trees by the 13<sup>th</sup> green and the start of the mound separating the 16<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> fairways, will have a small, shallow bunker put in.
